2010 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – ANL Maritime Art Prize & Exhibition

1. The ANL Art Prize is exhibited from 8th – 31st October, 2010 open for public display from the 9th October at 717 Flinders Street, Docklands, Vic, AUSTRALIA Mon – Wed from 12noon – 7pm
2. Artists are invited to submit up to 2 works for the acquisitive 'ANL Maritime Art Prize', valued at \$15,000, the "Best in Traditional Maritime Art Award" acquisitive Prize, sponsored by ASP Ship Management valued at \$5,000 and the non-acquisitive People's Choice Award valued at \$2,000
3. Works eligible. Proposed work(s) – traditional or contemporary, with a maritime theme, must be either painting/image-making utilising any medium, but specifically excluding photographic or computer generated images, prints, ceramics or sculptures
4. Artists are invited to submit up to two (2) works both are eligible for selection. Works must not to exceed 140cm x 140cm. Multiple panel proposals must not exceed 140 x 140cm and are to be accompanied by a clear image of the assembled work and hanging instructions
5. The signed Declaration and completed Entry Form is to be returned to by closing date together with the other items in the submission check list on page 2 of this form
6. Entry fee is \$33.00 (inc. GST) for each submission. Payment may be made by cheque or money order payable to The Mission to Seafarers Victoria or with credit card details on the entry form. Please note that entry fees are non-refundable
7. Closing date for entries : Friday 3rd September 2010. Send your completed entry form to:

8. **Selected artists: will be notified** by mail by Wednesday 15th September and are invited to deliver their work to 717 Flinders Street, Docklands, Victoria 3008 (Melways Ref 43:E10) on Saturday 18th or Monday 20th September. Work must be completely dry when delivered
9. Works must be well presented, well labelled on the back, ready to be hung with secure hooks and hanging wires
10. The Art Prize Committee reserves the right to reject any wet, dangerous or delicate works that cannot be safely exhibited, or any work received in unsuitable exhibition condition
11. The selection panel and the judges' decision will be final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into
12. **Judging** for the ANL Art Prize will take place on Tuesday 5th October and the winner will be contacted on this day. **Winners will be announced at the Official Opening** to be held at 6.30pm on Friday 8th October. Artists are invited to attend with a guest. The winner of the People's Choice Award will be announced at the conclusion of the exhibition
13. The work is for sale and attracts a 33% commission. Commission will also apply to the sale of any works exhibited in this exhibition within two (2) months of the last day of the exhibition. Artist will be notified of sale of works and payments will be made within 30 days of sale. Proceeds from sales support MTSV fundraising
14. The Art Prize Committee reserves the right to reproduce any works for promotional purposes
15. **Collection** of all unsold works at the conclusion of the Exhibition is the sole responsibility of the artist. Works are to be collected between 10am and 4pm on either Wednesday 3rd or Thursday 4th November. An artist's signed authority is required if an agent of the artist is collecting
16. If works are not collected within 3 months of collection date, work will be disposed of at the discretion of The Art Prize Committee and/or the Management of The Mission to Seafarers Victoria Inc.
